Black History Month Events

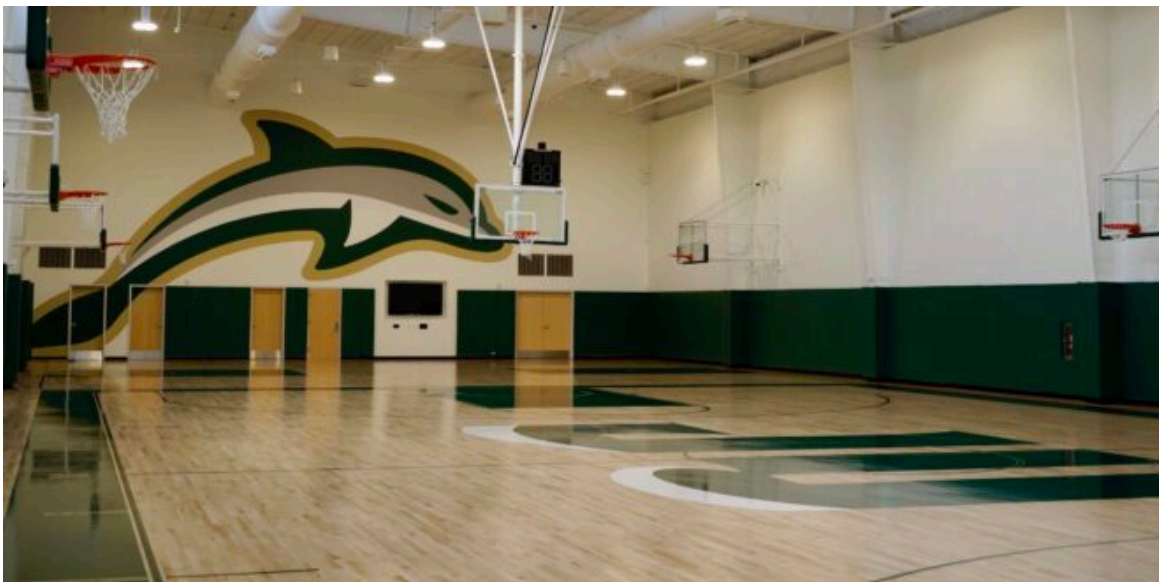
This year's Black History Month celebration at Jacksonville University focuses on celebrating Black culture, encouraging wellness and self-care and connecting with others on campus.

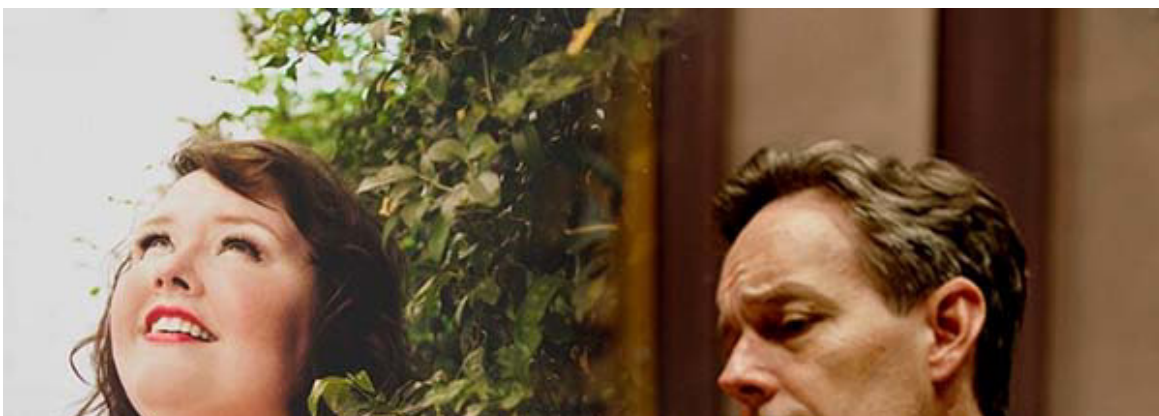

Recently, Assistant Professor of Design Ron Edelen saw one of his latest freelance projects land on one of the most popular areas in America - Times Square.

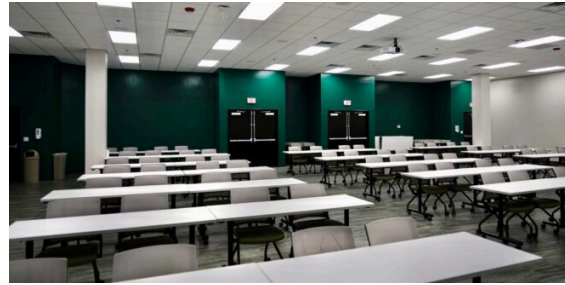

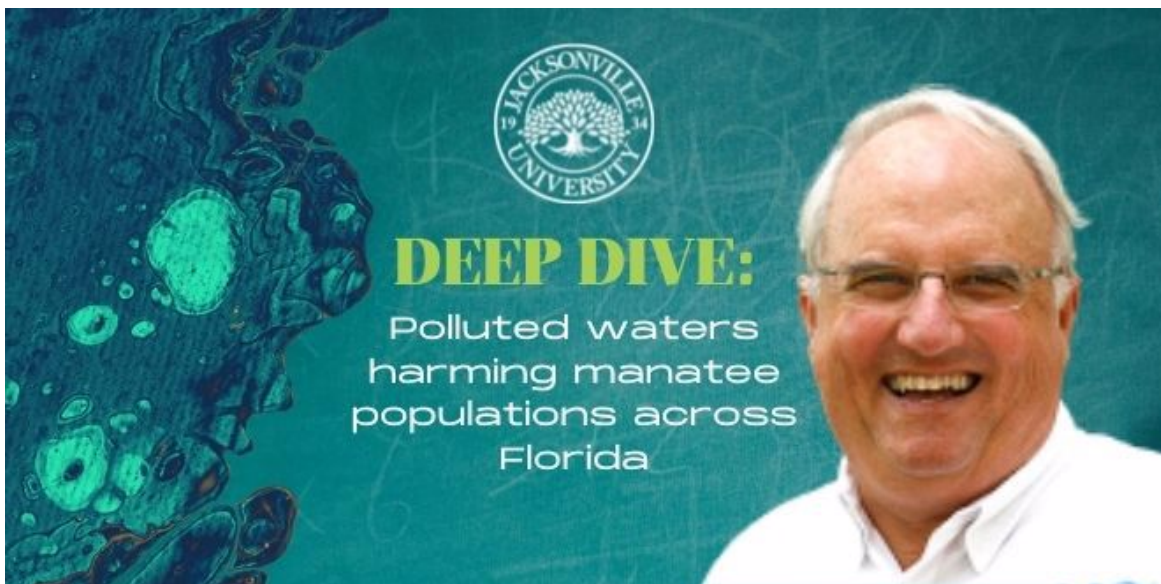
