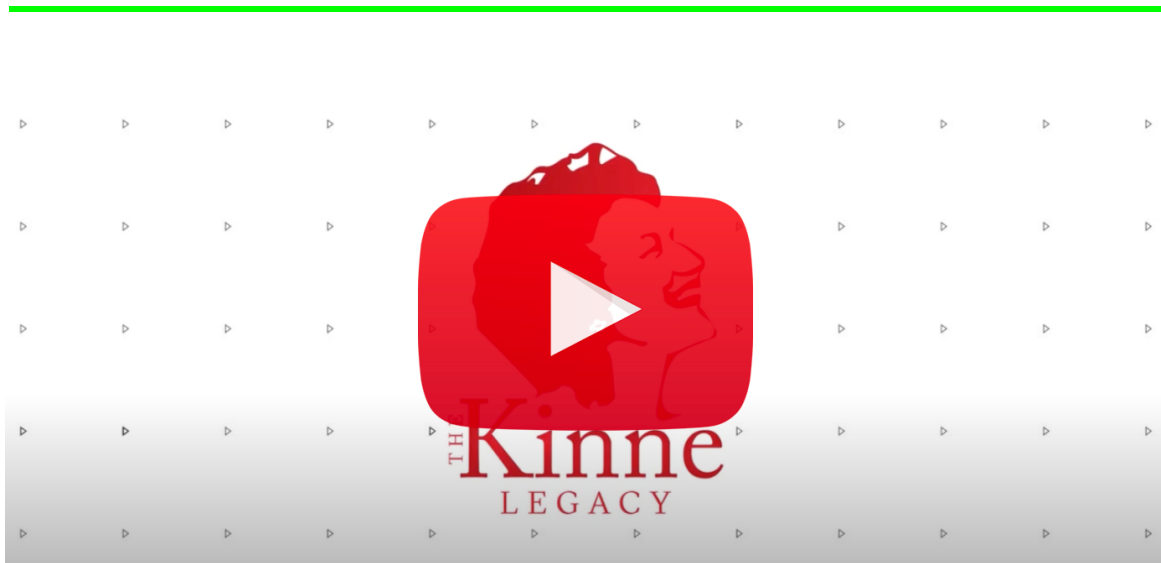


Distinguished Alumni Award Nominations are Open

Brooks College Achieves Accreditation



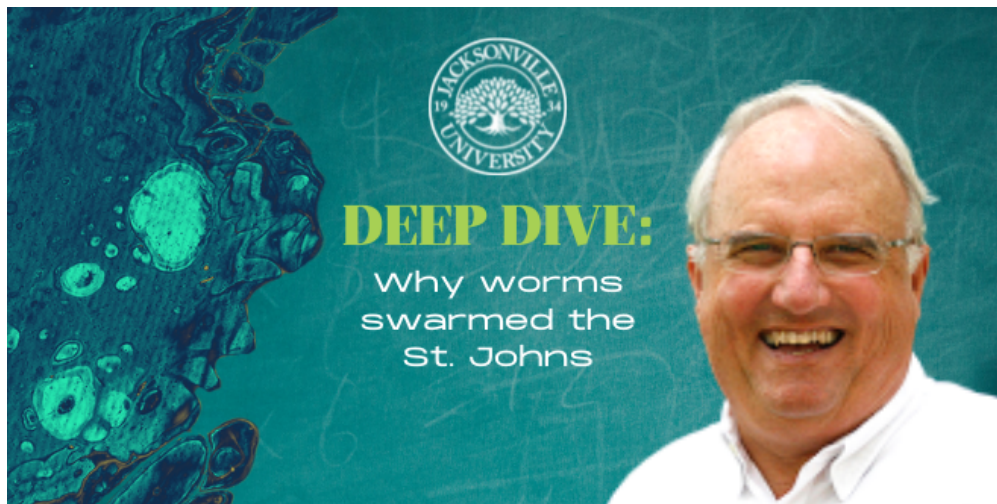
IDEA River Bluff Breaks Ground South of Campus
