JU Expands Partnership with Brooks Rehabilitation

Continuing its commitment to educating and training skilled healthcare workers to meet the rising demand for quality clinical services in Northeast Florida and beyond, Jacksonville University (JU) announced the expansion of its relationship with longstanding partner Brooks Rehabilitation. A \$1.5 million commitment from Brooks Rehabilitation will support the creation of a new Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) program in the Jacksonville University Brooks Rehabilitation College of Healthcare Sciences School of Applied Health Sciences and will create the Brooks Rehabilitation Nursing Excellence Scholarship program within the Keigwin School of Nursing.

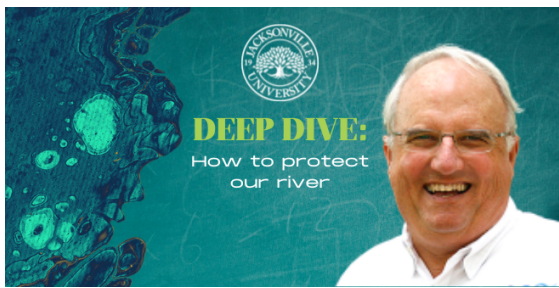
